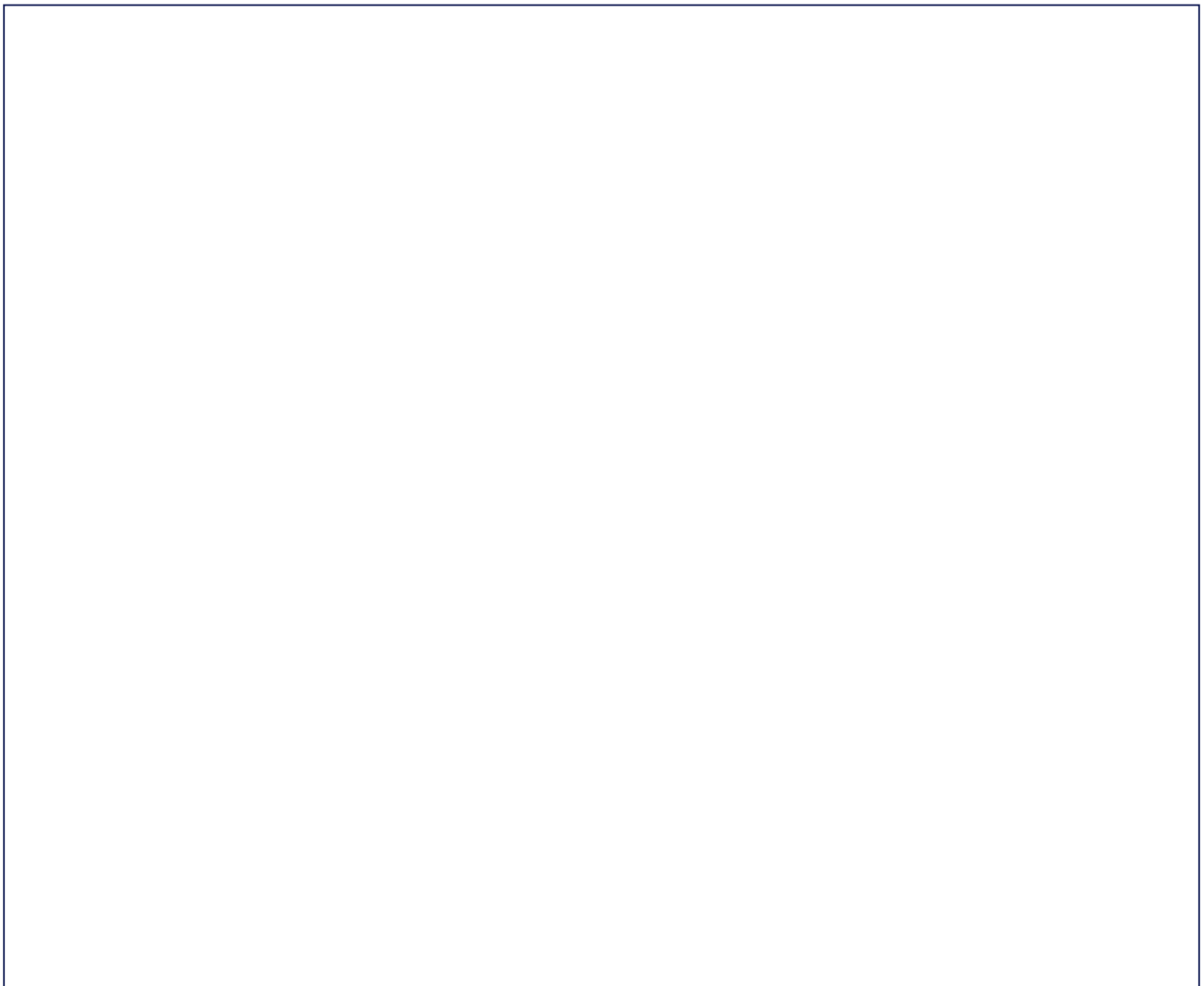


# Mapping Our World with Finn the Dolphin

*Learning objective: To identify and draw features of physical and human geography.*

Finn the dolphin needs your help to map his favourite coastline! Follow the steps below to draw a landscape that shows both natural features and things built by people.

**Draw: Draw a bright, colourful landscape scene. On the left, include a large, craggy mountain. In the middle, show a blue river winding down towards a sandy beach. On the right side, add a small village with two simple houses, a grey road, and a bridge crossing over the river. Use a landscape orientation.**



*Label words: Mountain · River · Beach · Bridge · Houses · Road*

## Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a tall mountain on the left side of your page. Label the mountain.
2. Step 2: Draw a river flowing from the mountain to the sea. Label the river.
3. Step 3: Draw a small village with two houses and a road near the beach. Label the houses and the road.
4. Step 4: Draw a bridge over the river. Label the bridge.
