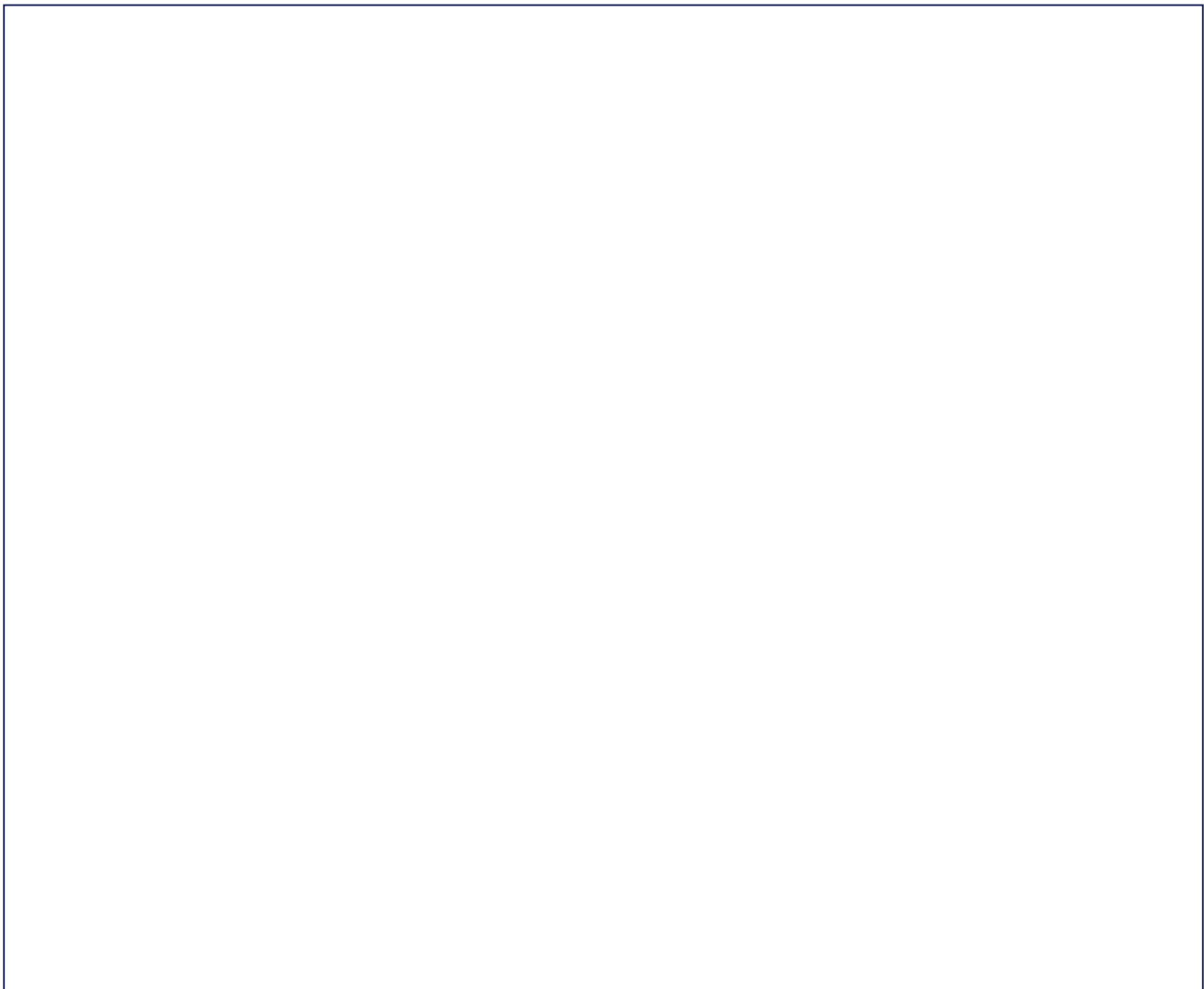


Finn's Polar Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and draw key physical features of the Arctic and Antarctic regions.

Finn the dolphin is visiting the cold polar regions. Follow the steps below to complete your drawing. Use the word bank to help you label your picture.

Draw: Draw a landscape of a polar region. The scene should include a deep blue ocean, a tall white iceberg floating in the middle, and a snowy coastline with a large glacier on the land. Use cool colours like white, light blue, and grey. Draw Finn the dolphin swimming near the surface of the water.



Label words: Iceberg · Glacier · Snow · Sea ice · Cold ocean

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, jagged shape in the water to represent an iceberg. Label it.
2. Step 2: Draw thick white lines on the land to show where the glacier sits. Label it.
3. Step 3: Draw Finn the dolphin swimming in the water. How does he keep warm? (Hint: He has a thick layer of blubber).
4. Step 4: Draw some falling flakes of snow in the sky. Label the snow.
