Emergent layer	Canopy
Which layer is dark and cool, found just below the canopy?	What is the bottom layer of the rainforest called?
Understory	Forest floor
What word means a large variety of plants and animals living in one place?	Why are rainforests important for the air we breathe?
Biodiversity	They produce oxygen
What is the amount of water vapour in the air called?	What do we call the typical weather pattern of a place over a long time?
