

Finn's Sustainable Ocean Challenge

Learning objective: To understand how we can protect our planet by making sustainable choices.

Finn the dolphin needs your help! He wants to keep our oceans clean and healthy. Look at the items in the list below. Decide if each item is 'Good for the Planet' (Sustainable) or 'Bad for the Planet' (Wasteful). Write each item in the correct box in the table.

Word bank: Reusable water bottle · Plastic straw · Cloth shopping bag · Single-use plastic bag · Paper recycling · Throwing litter in the sea

1. Draw a table with two columns: 'Good for the Planet' and 'Bad for the Planet'. Sort the items from the word bank into the correct columns. (6 marks)

2. Why is it better to use a reusable water bottle instead of a plastic one? (2 marks)

3. What is one thing you can do at home to help stop waste? (2 marks)

4. If a reusable bag costs £1, and you use it 10 times, you save money compared to buying 10 plastic bags at 10p each. How much money do you save in total? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Finn the dolphin swimming in a clean, blue ocean. Make sure there is no plastic in the water!



Extension challenge: Imagine you are an ocean explorer. Write a short promise to Finn about one thing you will do this week to keep the Earth sustainable.
