

Finn's Global Trading Adventure

Learning objective: To understand how goods are traded between countries and identify items that are imported to the UK.

Finn the dolphin is travelling across the ocean to help bring goods to the UK. Look at the items in the list below. Decide if each item is likely to be 'Imported' (brought into the UK from another country) or 'Grown or Made in the UK'. Write your answer in the box next to each item.
