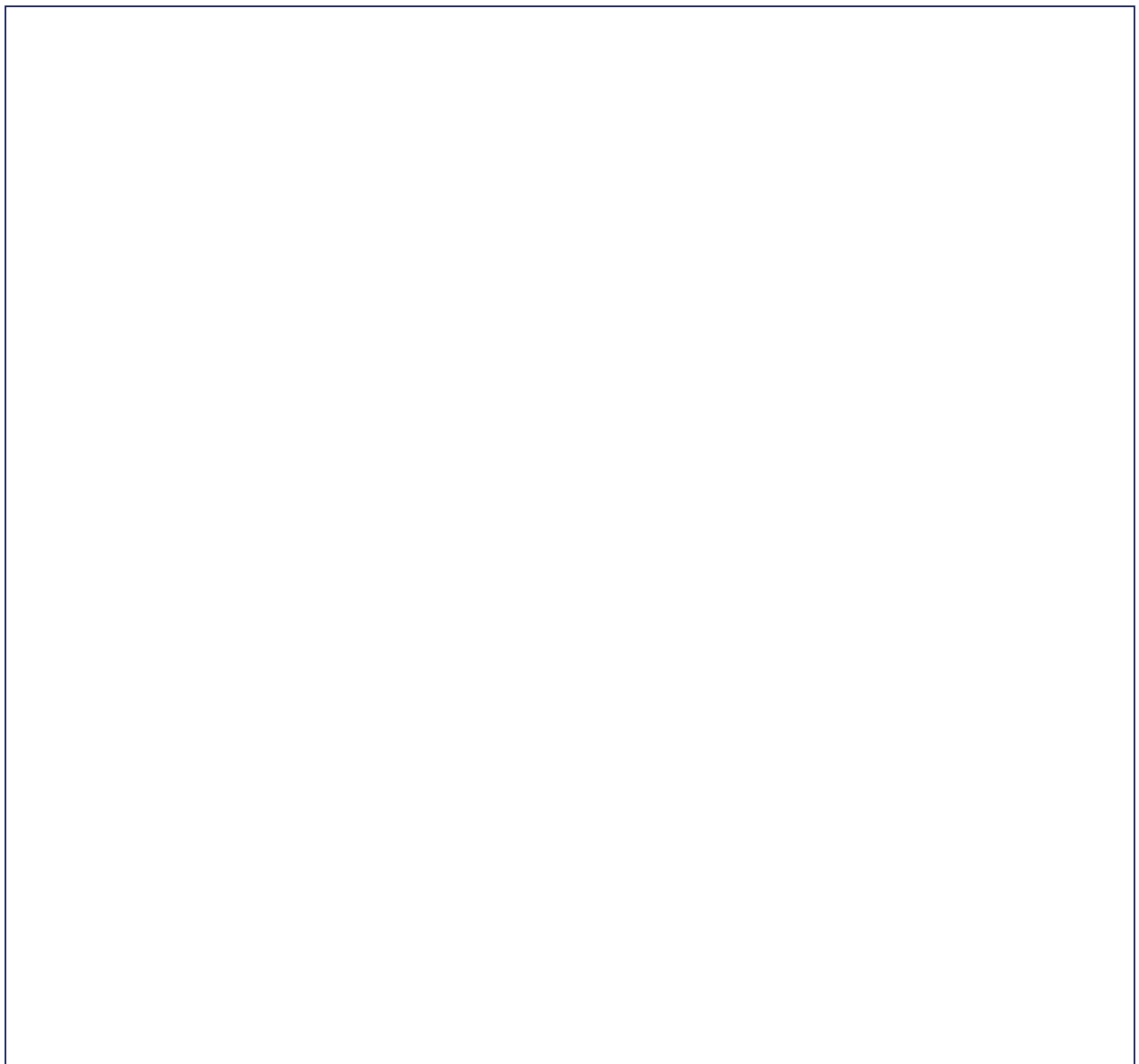


Finn's Volcanic Adventure

Learning objective: To identify the features of a volcano and understand that they are part of the Earth's physical geography.

Read the facts about volcanoes below. Colour in the picture of Finn the dolphin exploring a volcanic island. Use your pencils to label the parts of the volcano as shown in the questions.

Colour this: A large, clear outline of a cone-shaped volcano rising out of the blue ocean. Finn the dolphin is visible in the bottom corner of the scene, wearing a small explorer's hat and looking through a magnifying glass at the island. The volcano has a distinct opening at the top (crater) and thick, wiggly lines flowing down the side representing lava. In the background, there is a simple sun and a few fluffy clouds. The lines should be bold and thick, suitable for a 5-6 year old to colour within.



Steps:

1. Label the top of the volcano where the lava comes out (the crater).
2. Label the flowing, hot liquid running down the side of the volcano (the lava).
