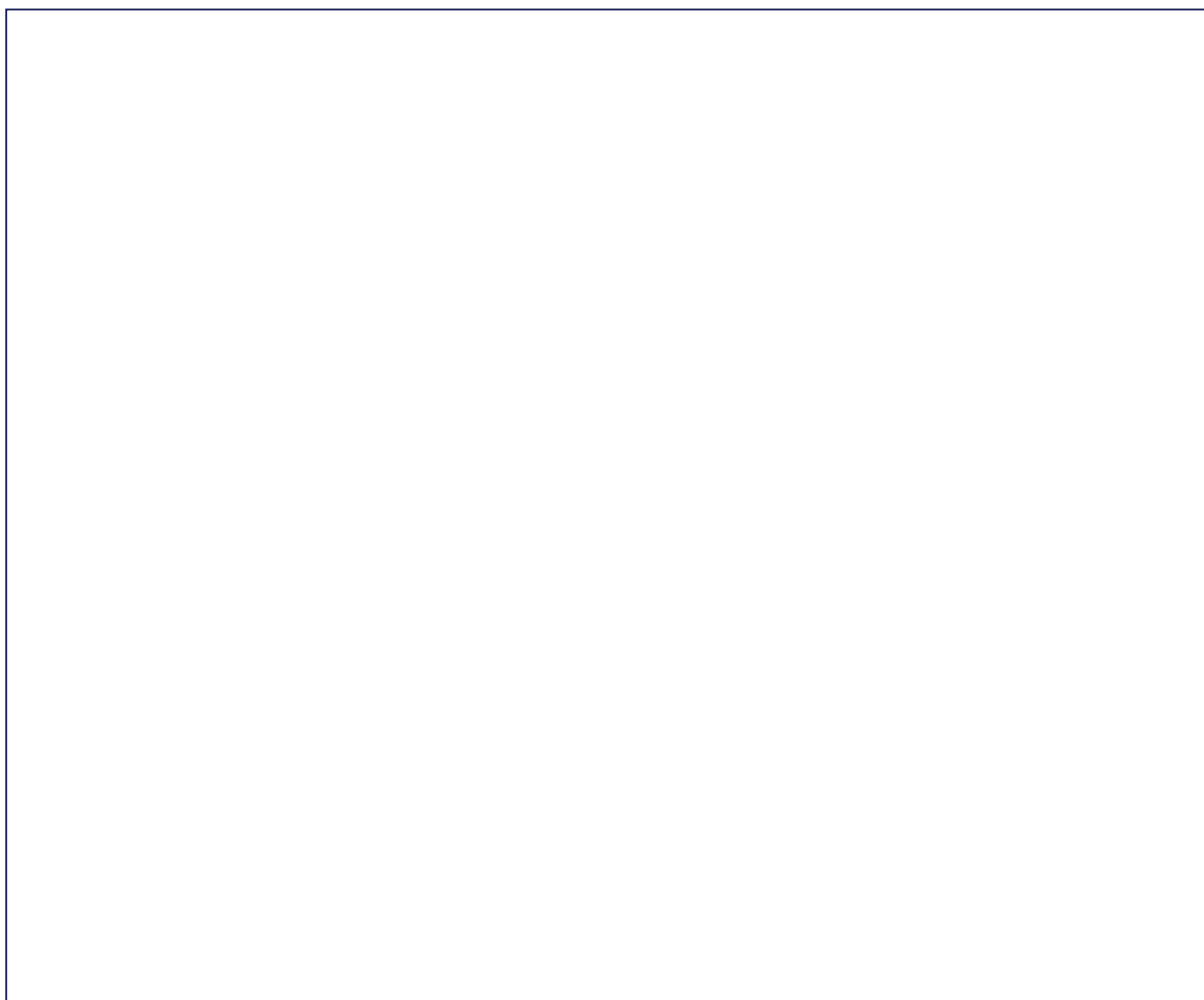


Finn's Volcanic Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and label the key physical features of a volcano.

Finn the dolphin is exploring a tropical island that has a volcano! Use the word bank to label the different parts of the volcano on your drawing. Make sure to colour your picture to show the hot lava and the rocky mountain.

Draw: Draw a large, triangular volcanic mountain on a tropical island. Include a wide, circular crater at the top. Show bright red and orange lava flowing down one side of the mountain. Add grey, fluffy clouds of ash and smoke rising from the crater into the sky. Use bright colours for the island's grass and trees at the bottom of the mountain.



Label words: Crater · Lava · Mountain · Smoke · Ash

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, tall mountain shape in the middle of your paper. Make the top flat.
2. Step 2: Draw a red, squiggly line coming out of the top and running down the side of the mountain. Label this 'Lava'.
3. Step 3: Draw a grey cloud puffing out of the top of the mountain. Label this 'Smoke'.
4. Step 4: Label the opening at the very top of the mountain where the lava comes out. Use the word 'Crater'.
5. Step 5: Write one sentence about what colour the lava should be and why.
