- A volcano is a mountain that opens downwards to a pool of molten rock below the surface of the Earth.
- When the rock is deep underground, it is called magma. When it bursts out, we call it lava.
- The opening at the top of the volcano is called the crater. This is where the lava and ash come out.
- A vent is the pipe or tunnel that the magma travels through to reach the surface.
- Volcanoes are often found where the giant plates that make up the Earth's crust move and bump into each other.

Did you know? Did you know? When a volcano erupts, it can send ash and dust so high into the sky that it travels around the world on the wind!
