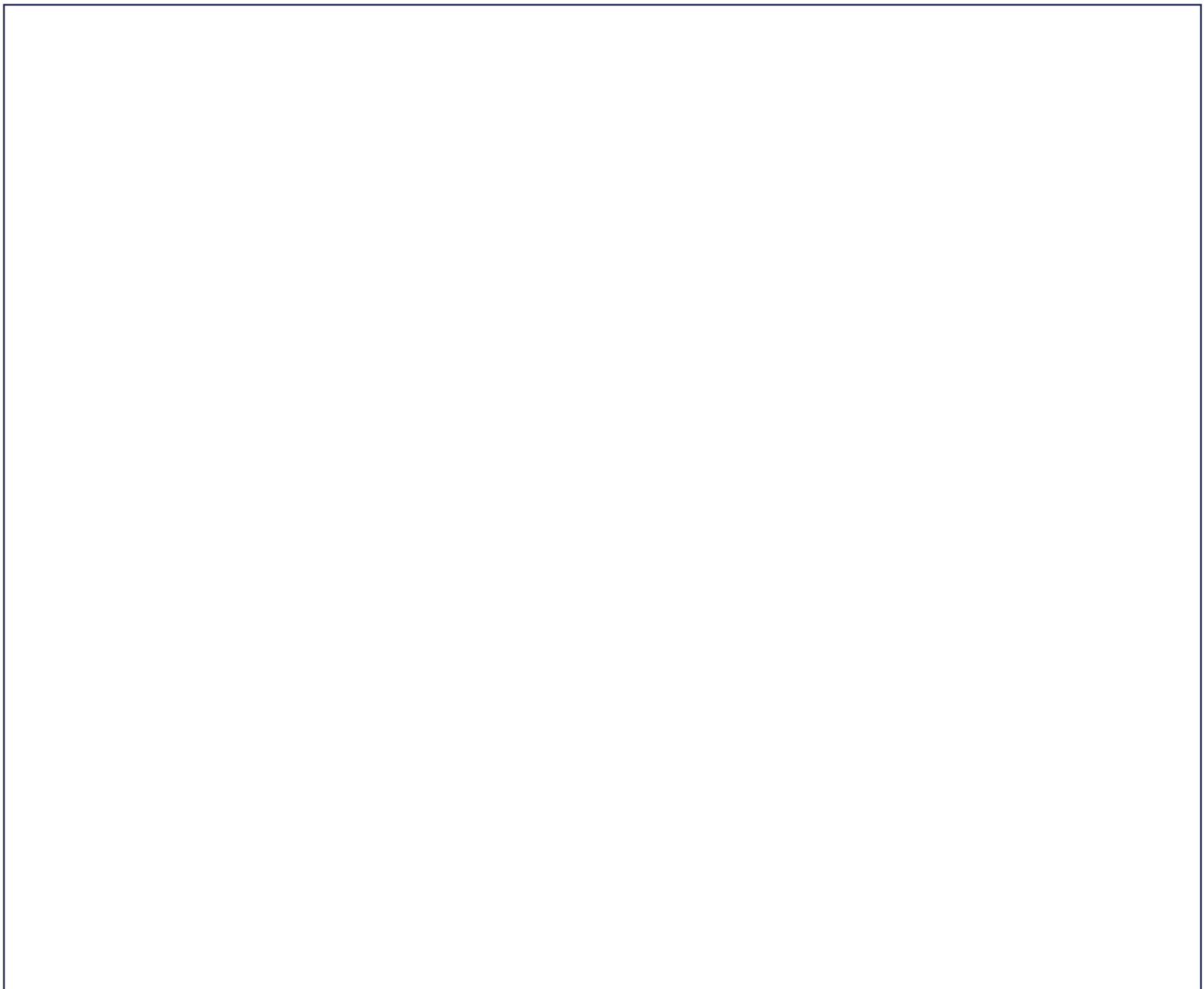


Ellie's History Heroes: Celebrating Mary Seacole

Learning objective: To learn about the life and work of Mary Seacole and represent her contributions through drawing.

Follow the steps below to draw a picture of Mary Seacole. Use the labels to help you add detail to your drawing. You can use your imagination to colour your picture.

Draw: Draw a bright, colourful scene showing Mary Seacole helping others. Include a building in the background representing the British Hotel. Use clear, simple shapes. Include a basket filled with medicine and care items. The style should be warm and encouraging.



Label words: Medicine · Hospital · Nurse · Jamaica · Crimea · Care · Kindness

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw Mary Seacole in the centre of your page. Draw her wearing a warm coat and a headscarf.
2. Step 2: Draw a building behind her. Label this as the 'British Hotel'.
3. Step 3: Draw some supplies in her basket, like medicine bottles or bandages.
4. Step 4: Label the items you have drawn using the words from the word bank.
