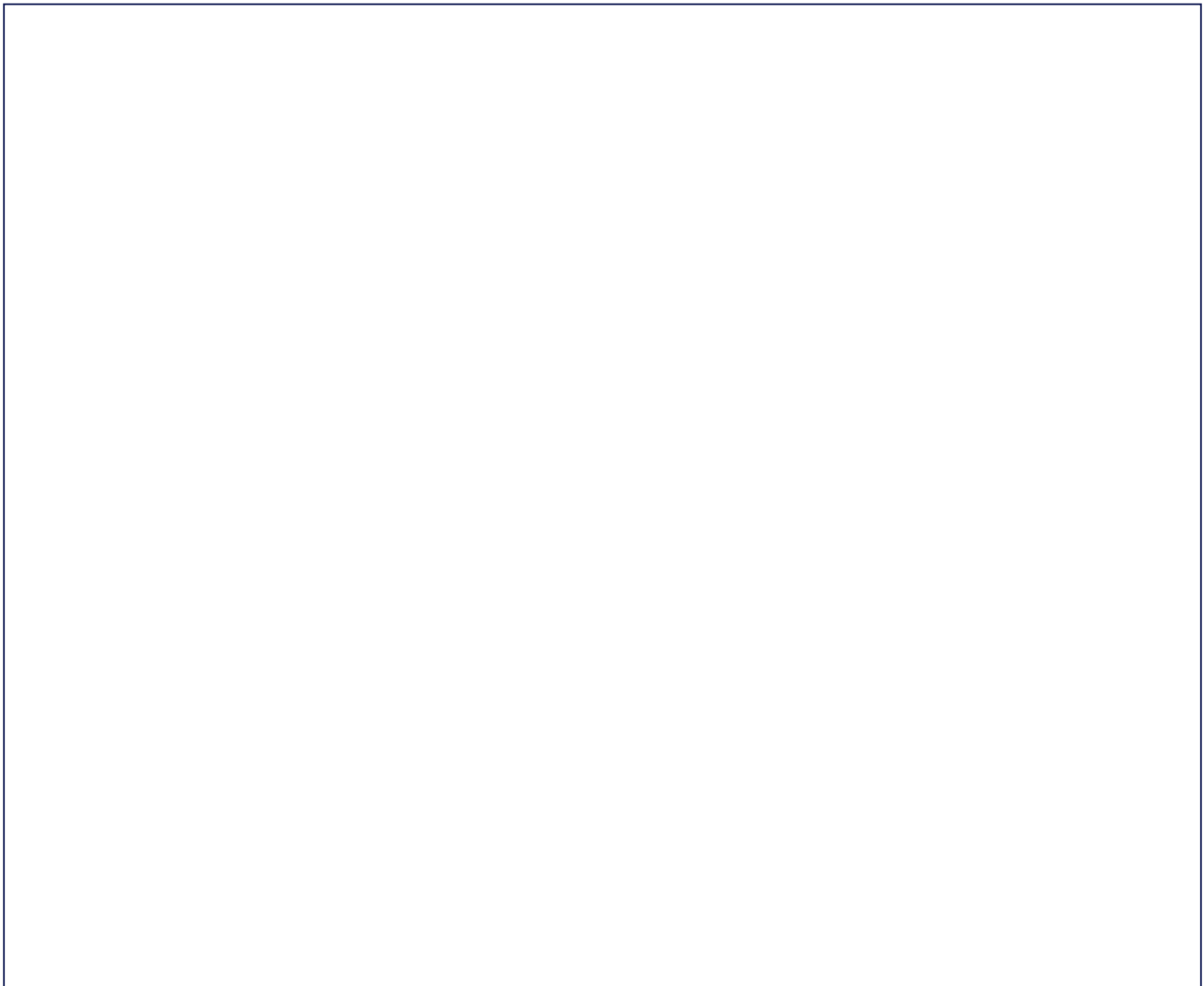


A Giant Leap: Neil Armstrong's Moon Walk

Learning objective: To understand the significance of the first moon landing and identify key features of an astronaut's equipment.

Follow the drawing prompt to illustrate the historic moon landing. Use the word bank to label your picture clearly.

Draw: Draw a scene of the Moon landing. In the centre, draw an astronaut wearing a large, round helmet and a thick white suit. Under the astronaut's feet, draw the grey, dusty surface of the Moon with some craters (small circles). To the side, draw a tall flagpole with a flag waving. In the background, draw a large, metallic spacecraft. The style should be clear and simple, using bright colours for the flag and dark colours for the space around the Moon.



Label words: Moon · Astronaut · Spacesuit · Flag · Spacecraft

Steps:

1. Who was the first person to walk on the Moon?
2. Why did Neil Armstrong need to wear a special spacesuit?
3. What colour was the surface of the Moon that Neil Armstrong walked on?
4. Label your drawing to show where the spacecraft is.
5. Draw a small star in the sky to show where Nova the owl might be watching from!
