

Nova's Moon Landing Mission

Learning objective: To identify key features of the Apollo 11 moon landing and Neil Armstrong's historic achievement.

Follow the steps below to complete your space scene. Use the word bank to add labels to your drawing.

Draw: Create a clear, simple drawing of the Moon landing. The style should be bold and colourful. Include the Moon's surface with craters, the Eagle lander spacecraft, the flag, and Neil Armstrong in his white spacesuit. Leave space around the objects to add labels from the provided word bank.



Label words: Spacesuit · Eagle Lander · Moon Surface · Flag · Footprint

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large circle in the middle of your page to represent the Moon. Add some small craters on the surface.
2. Step 2: Draw Neil Armstrong standing on the Moon. Remember to draw him wearing his protective white spacesuit.
3. Step 3: Draw the Eagle lander nearby. Add a flag next to Neil Armstrong.
4. Step 4: Label your drawing using the words from the word bank.
