

Design a Roman Soldier's Armour

Learning objective: To identify and label the key pieces of equipment used by a Roman soldier.

Use the word bank to help you label the parts of the armour on the drawing. Follow the steps below to complete your soldier's outfit.

Draw: Draw a Roman soldier standing tall in the centre of the page. The style should be clear and simple, like a textbook diagram. Leave enough space around the soldier for clear labels to be drawn with lines pointing to the armour pieces.



Label words: Helmet · Breastplate · Shield · Sword · Sandals

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a protective helmet on the soldier's head. Label it.
2. Step 2: Draw a strong metal breastplate on the soldier's chest. Label it.
3. Step 3: Draw a large rectangular shield in the soldier's hand. Label it.
4. Step 4: Draw a short sword at the soldier's side. Label it.
