

Max's Christmas Market Maths

Learning objective: To apply addition and subtraction of money to a festive scene and develop mathematical drawing skills.

Max the monkey is visiting the Christmas market! Help him decorate his market stall and calculate the cost of his treats. Read the prompts and draw your items in the space provided, then answer the questions.

Draw: In the large empty box below, draw a Christmas market stall. Include: 1) A wooden stall with a roof, 2) Four red baubles hanging from the front, 3) A bright yellow star on the top of the stall, 4) A small bag of nuts sitting on the counter. Use bright colours and clear, bold lines to make your stall look festive and welcoming for Max.



Label words: bauble · tinsel · star · coin · price tag · stall

Steps:

1. How much money does Max spend altogether on the star and the nuts? Show your working.
2. How much change does Max have left from his £10 note?
3. If Max buys 2 more baubles for his stall, how many baubles will he have in total? Draw the total number of baubles.
4. Draw a price tag on your stall. If a candy cane costs 50p, write '50p' on the tag.
5. Label your drawing using at least three words from the word bank.
