

Max's Easter Market Maths

Learning objective: To solve one-step problems involving addition and subtraction of money in Australian dollars and cents.

Max the Monkey is helping at the Easter Market. He needs to work out how much his friends are spending on their treats. Read the price list and help Max solve the maths puzzles below. Use your addition and subtraction skills to find the total or the change.

Word bank: total · change · add · subtract · pence · pounds

1. Pip buys a chocolate egg for £2 and a bunch of daffodils for £3. What is the total cost? (2 marks)

2. Nova has £10. She spends £4 on a basket. How much money does she have left? (2 marks)

3. Ellie buys a bunny toy for £5 and a ribbon for £2. How much does she spend altogether? (2 marks)

4. Finn has £9. He buys a gift for £7. How much change does he get back? (2 marks)

5. Zara wants to buy two stickers. Each sticker costs £1. What is the total price for both? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the Monkey holding a basket filled with the items from the market. Label the price of each item using the £ symbol.



Extension challenge: If you had £10, which three items from the market would you choose to buy? Write down your items and work out the total cost. Do you have any money left over?
