Hop into maths! Can you solve these Easter challenges with Max the Monkey?

- If a small foil-wrapped egg costs 20p, two eggs will cost 40p in total.
- To work out the total cost of your basket, add up the price of each item carefully.
- When you pay with a £1 coin for an item costing 70p, your change will be 30p.
- Remember that 100 pence is the same as £1.00.
- Max always checks his receipt to make sure his addition is correct.

Did you know? Did you know? Max loves to count his Easter treats! If one chocolate egg costs 50p, then two eggs cost £1.00. Max says that knowing your times tables makes counting your coins much faster!
