Operations Addition is finding the total of two or more numbers. Subtraction is taking one number away from another. Multiplication is finding the total of a number multiplied by another number. Division is splitting a number into equal parts.	Data A tally chart uses lines to count items. A bar chart uses bars to represent data. A line graph shows how something changes over time.
