

Max's Measurement Mission

Learning objective: To measure, compare, add, and subtract lengths and money using standard units.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank if you get stuck. Write your answers clearly in the spaces provided.

Max the monkey is helping his friends get ready for a party. He needs to measure ribbons for decorations and count the money for snacks.

Word bank: centimetres · metres · total · difference · pence · pounds

1. 1. Max has a piece of blue ribbon that is 45 centimetres long. He has a red ribbon that is 30 centimetres long. What is the total length of both ribbons? (Calculation: $45 + 30 =$) (2 marks)

2. 2. A bunch of bananas costs £2.50. Max has a £5.00 note. How much change should Max get back? (Calculation: $£5.00 - £2.50 =$) (2 marks)

3. 3. The garden fence is 8 metres long. Pip the caterpillar crawls 3 metres along it. How many metres does Pip have left to crawl? (Calculation: $8 - 3 =$) (2 marks)

4. 4. Ellie the elephant buys a bag of peanuts for £1.20 and a drink for £0.80. How much does she spend in total? Show your working out. (4 marks)

5. 5. Max wants to hang a banner across the room. The room is 6 metres wide. He has two pieces of banner. One is 2 metres and the other is 3 metres. Is the banner long enough to go all the way across? Explain your answer using what you know about measurement. (5 marks)

Draw: Draw a line that is exactly 5 centimetres long using a ruler.



Extension challenge: Max has £10.00. He buys three items that cost £2.00 each. How much money does Max have left? Show your steps. Total: /25
