

Max's Market Measurement Challenge

Learning objective: To measure and compare the mass of items using kilograms and grams, and calculate total costs using Australian dollars and cents.

Hello! I am Max the monkey. I am at the fruit market today. Use this sheet to help me record the weight of my fruit and calculate the total cost. Look at the scales to see the weight. Use the word bank if you need help with your spelling.

Word bank: kilograms · grams · total · cost · mass · scales

1. Item 1: Look at the bag of apples. What is the mass in kilograms or grams? Write your answer here: (2 marks)

2. Item 2: If the apples cost £2.50 and a banana costs £0.50, what is the total cost? (2 marks)

3. Comparison: Which item is heavier, the bag of apples or the banana? Explain how you know. (2 marks)

4. Calculation: If Max has £5.00 and spends £3.00, how much change should he get back? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you draw a picture of a set of scales showing 500 grams of strawberries?
