

Max the Monkey's Money Masterclass

Get your pockets ready for a maths adventure with Max the Monkey!

- There are 100 pence (p) in every 1 pound (£1).
- We use silver coins for 5p, 10p, 20p, and 50p, and gold-coloured coins for £1 and £2.
- To find the total, you add the value of all the coins together.
- If you pay with more money than the item costs, you get 'change' back.
- We always write the pound sign (£) before the number, like £5.

Did you know? Did you know? Before coins and notes were invented, people used to trade things like shells, beads, or even salt to pay for items they wanted! It is much easier to carry a purse or wallet today.
