4. 4. Which is the highest value? A) 50p B) 90p* C) 5p D) 20p (1 mark)

5. 5. True or False: A £5 note is worth less than a £2 coin. (1 mark)

6. 6. Max has 20p. He spends 10p on a sticker. How much change does he have left? (1 mark)

7. 7. Which coin is a 'two pound' coin? A) 2p B) £1 C) £2* D) 50p (1 mark)

8. 8. True or False: You can make 30p using three 10p coins. (1 mark)

9. 9. Max finds a 20p coin, a 20p coin, and a 10p coin in his pocket. What is the total? (1 mark)

10. 10. Max has a 50p coin and a 20p coin. How much money does he have altogether? (1 mark)
