

Max the Monkey's Money Flashcards

Learning objective: To identify and use money notation, convert between Australian dollars and cents, and solve simple money problems.

Read the front of the card. Try to say the answer out loud. Then, check the back of the card to see if you are right. Use the word bank if you get stuck!

How many pence are in £1?	Write 50p as pounds using a decimal point.
100 pence.	£0.50
If you have £1.00 and spend 20p, how much do you have left?	What is the name of the dot used to separate Australian dollars and cents?
80p.	A decimal point.
Max buys a banana for 30p and an apple for 20p. What is the total?	Which is more: £1.50 or £1.05?
50p.	£1.50.
If an item costs 75p, what do you need to add to make £1.00?	How do you write three pounds and ten pence?
25p.	£3.10
You have £2.00. You spend £1.00. How much change do you get?	Is 10p smaller or larger than 100p?
£1.00.	Smaller.
Max has 40p. He finds 10p. How much does he have now?	What do we call the money you get back after paying too much?
50p.	Change.
