

Max the Monkey's Rounding Adventure

Learning objective: To round any number to the nearest 10, 100, or 1000.

Max needs your help to sort his fruit collection! Follow the steps below to round the numbers to the nearest 10 or 100. Look at the digit in the place value to the right to help you decide if you should round up or round down.

Word bank: round up · round down · nearest ten · nearest hundred · place value · digit

1. Max has 43 apples. Look at the digit in the ones column. Should we round up or round down to the nearest ten? Write your answer here: (2 marks)

2. Max has 158 bananas. Look at the digit in the tens column. Round this number to the nearest hundred. Write your answer here: (2 marks)

3. A monkey found 72 grapes. To round to the nearest ten, I look at the number 2. Since 2 is less than 5, I will: (2 marks)

4. Max has 87 pears. If I round to the nearest ten, the number becomes: (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Max has 245 pineapples. Can you round this number to the nearest 10 and then to the nearest 100?
