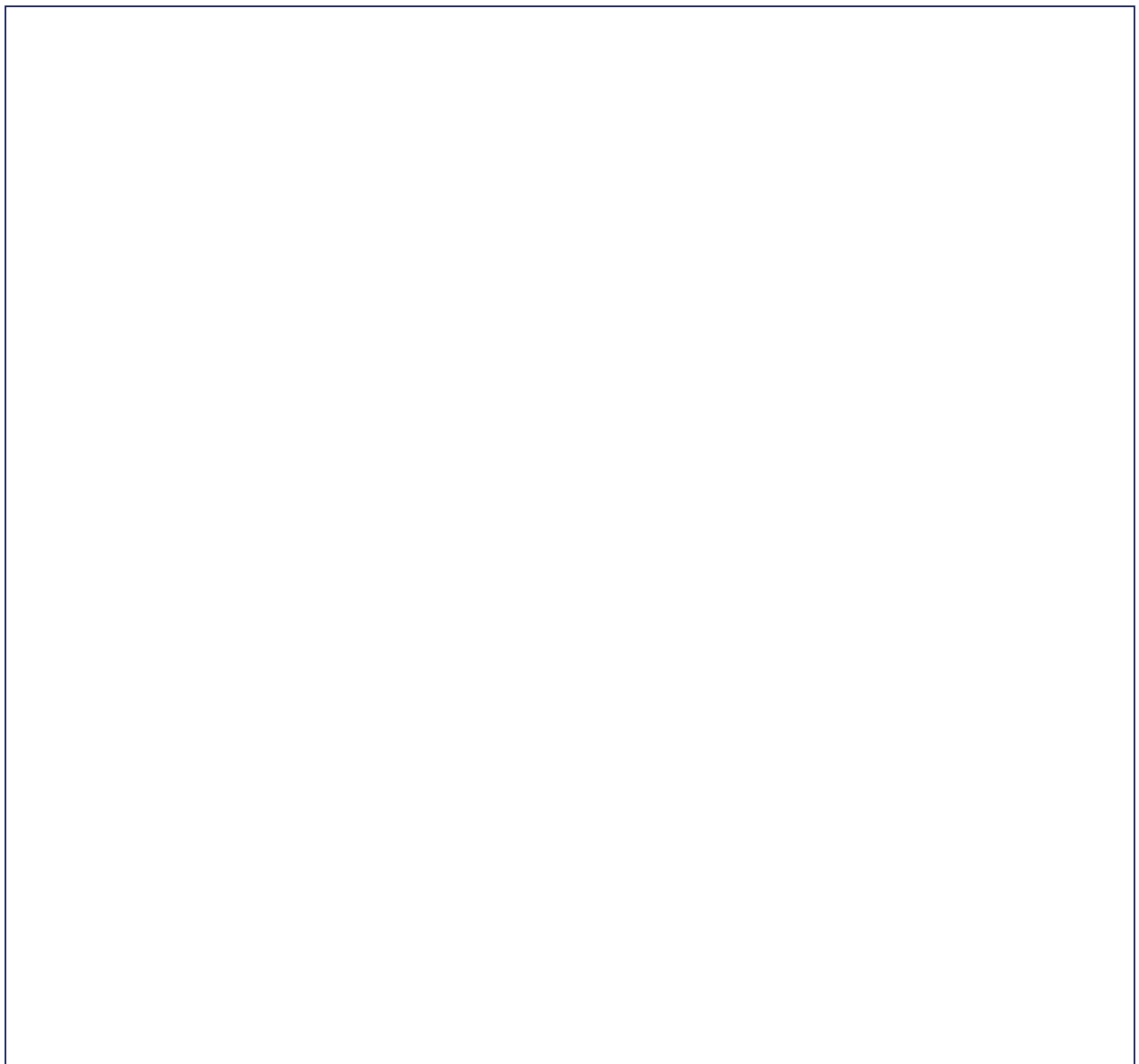


Max the Monkey's Shape Safari

Learning objective: To identify and describe the properties of 2D shapes, including the number of sides and vertices.

Help Max the Monkey organise his jungle supplies! Colour the shapes according to the key, then label the parts of the shapes as requested.

Colour this: A large, friendly drawing of Max the Monkey sitting in the centre of the page. He is holding a clipboard. Scattered around Max are various 2D shapes with clear, thick black outlines for colouring: three squares, three triangles, three circles, and three hexagons. The shapes should be distinct and large enough for a Year 2 student to colour neatly. One triangle should be resting on a tree branch, one square should be on the ground near Max's feet, and a circle should be floating like a bubble near his ear.



Steps:

1. Label the vertices (corners) on the square in the drawing.
2. Label the sides of the triangle in the drawing.
