6. 6. Max has £3 and earns £2 more. How much does he have in total? (1 mark)

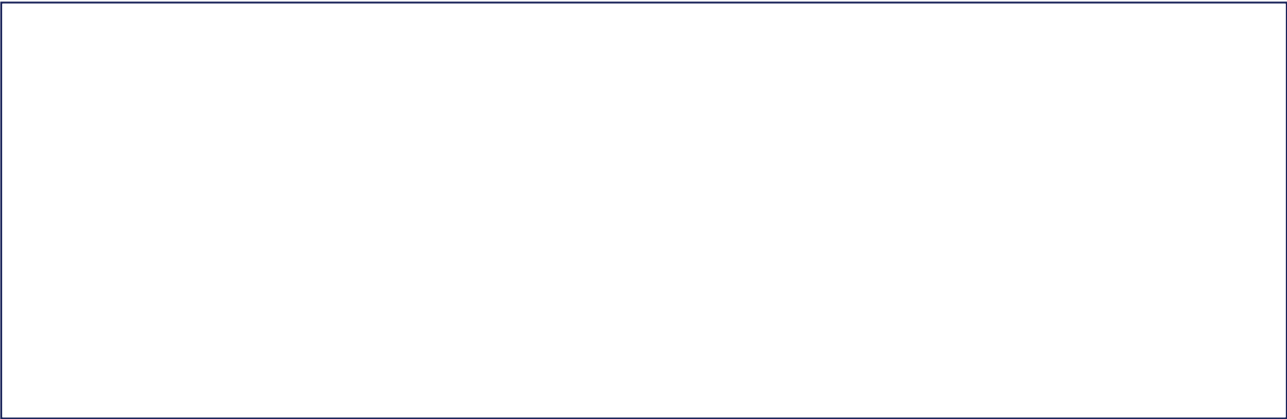
7. 7. What is a chart called that uses pictures instead of bars? (1 mark)
