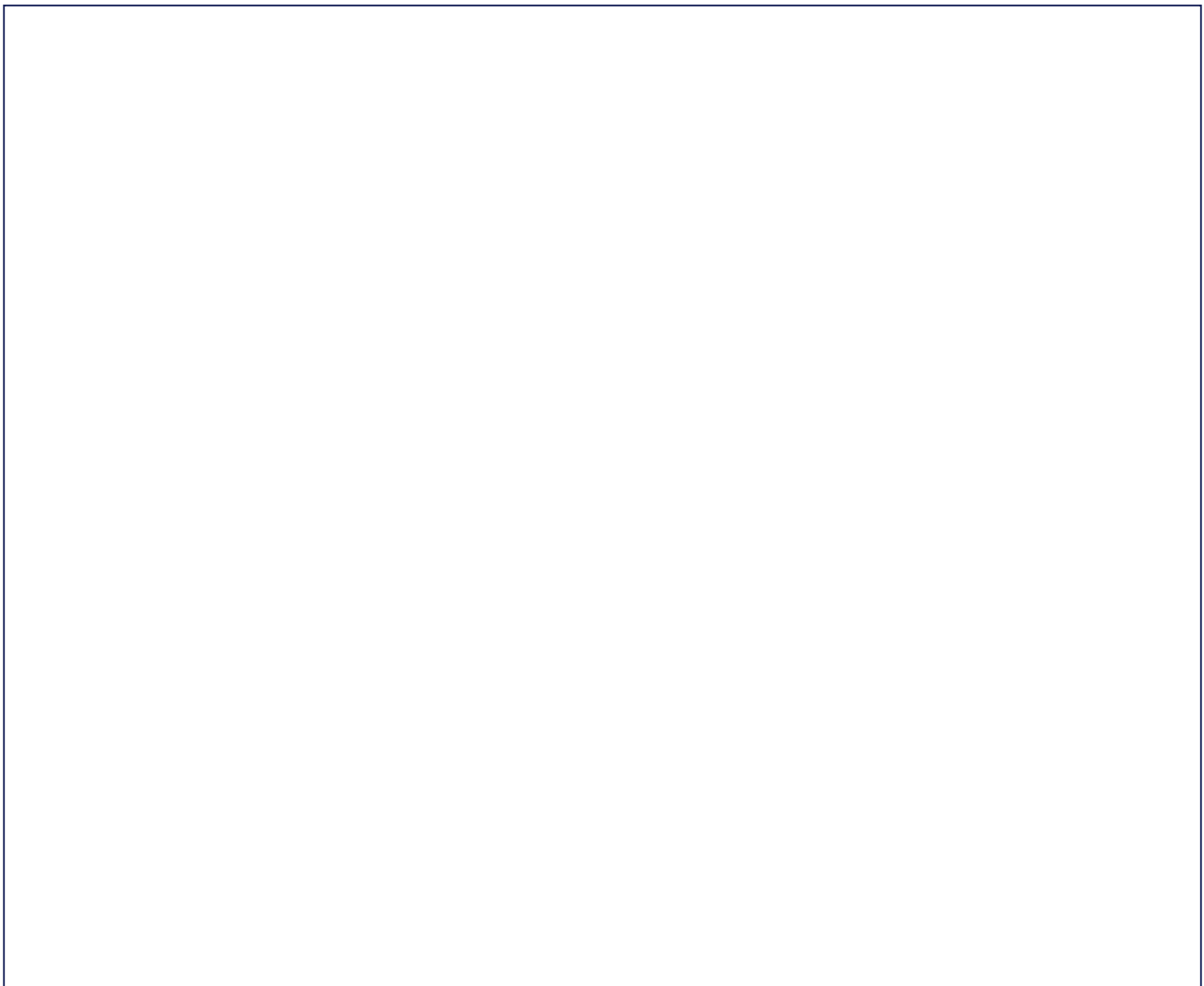


Celebrating Heroes: My Inspiration Drawing Sheet

Learning objective: To recognise that everyone is special and to celebrate the achievements of significant individuals who have helped others.

Today, we are learning about Black History Month. We are going to celebrate people who have been brave, kind, and have made the world a better place. Use the space below to draw someone who inspires you or someone you have learned about today.

Draw: Draw a large scene in the centre of the page. Include a person standing proudly. You might draw them wearing bright colours. Surround them with symbols of their achievements, such as stars, books, or flowers. Use markers or crayons to make your drawing colourful and bright.



Label words: Hero · Kind · Brave · Change · Helpful · Special

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a picture of a person you think is a hero in the big box below.
2. Step 2: Add a special item to your drawing that shows what they like to do (e.g., a book, a paintbrush, or a musical instrument).
3. Step 3: Can you write or trace one word from the word bank next to your hero?
4. Step 4: Who is the person in your drawing?

5. Step 5: Why is this person special to you?
