What is Diversity?

Diversity means that everyone is different and unique in their own way.

What is Inclusion?

Inclusion means making sure everyone feels welcome and part of the group.

What does it mean to be Unique?

Being unique means there is nobody else exactly like you.

What is Respect?

Respect is treating others kindly and listening to their ideas.

What is a Community?

A community is a group of people who live, work, or learn together.

What is Empathy?

Empathy is trying to understand how someone else is feeling.
