Learning objective: To identify how we change and grow as we get older and recognise the responsibilities that come with growing up.

1. 1. What are two things a baby might do? (Use the word bank) (2 marks)

2. 2. What are two things you can do now as a Year 4 child? (2 marks)

3. 3. What are two things grown-ups do that you might do in the future? (2 marks)

4. 4. Name one thing you can do now that you could not do when you were a baby. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of yourself doing something you love to do now that you are in Year 4.



Extension challenge: Talk to an adult at home. Ask them: 'What was your favourite thing to do when you were nine years old?' Write down their answer.
