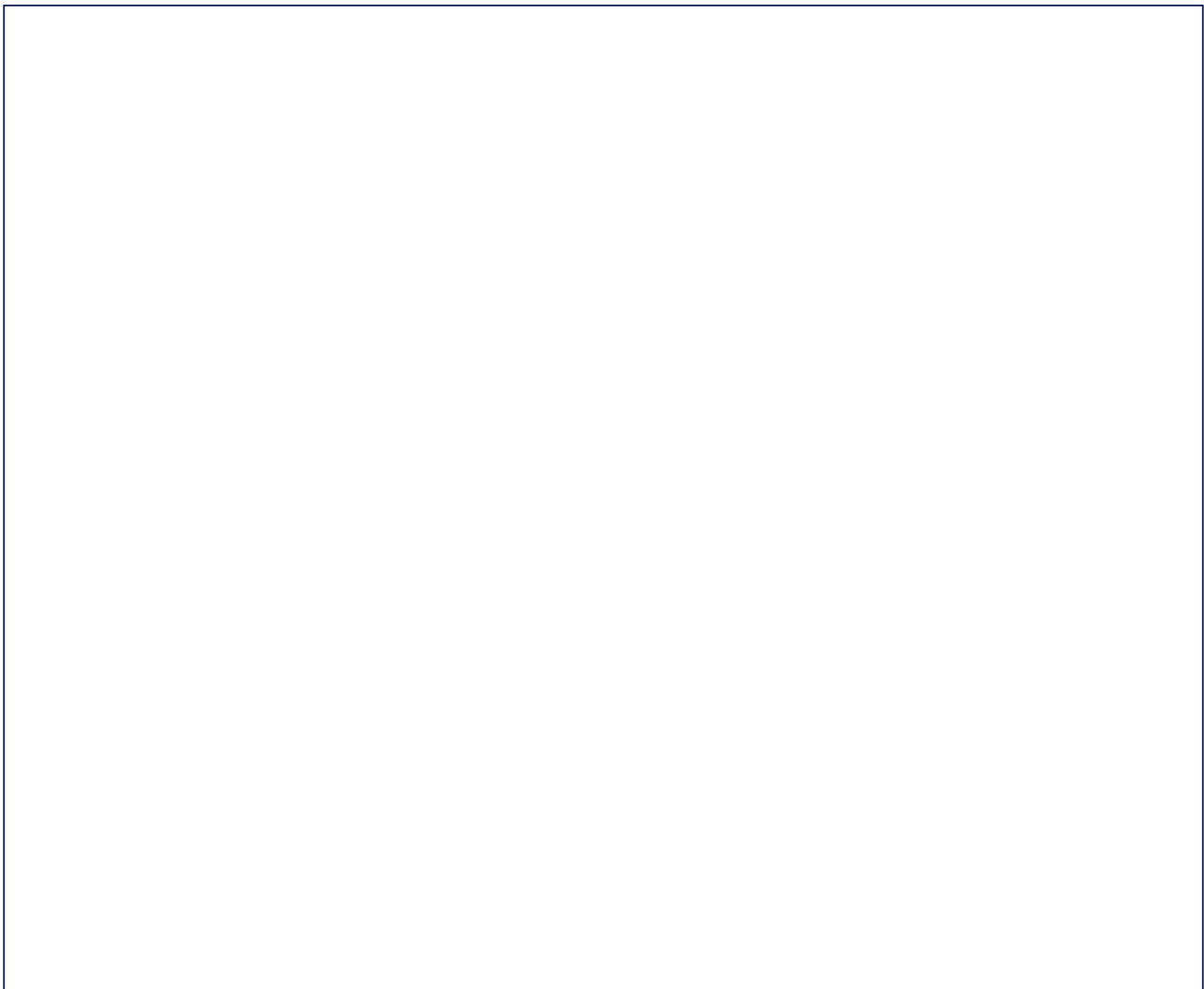


Growing Up with Leo the Lion

Learning objective: To identify how we change and grow as we get older and to recognise our personal achievements.

Leo the Lion is looking at his photo album! Use the drawing space to show how you have grown. Follow the steps below to complete your picture.

Draw: Divide the drawing area into two large squares. In the left square, draw yourself as a baby or toddler. In the right square, draw yourself as you are today at age 8 or 9. Add speech bubbles near Leo the Lion saying 'Look how much you have grown!' Use bright colours and clear outlines.



Label words: toddler · school age · skills · achievements · future · growth

Steps:

1. Step 1: In the first box, draw yourself as a younger child. What is one thing you could do then?
2. Step 2: In the second box, draw yourself now. What is one new skill you have learnt at school?
3. Step 3: Label your drawings using the words from the word bank.
4. Step 4: Write one sentence about something you are proud of achieving this year.
