

Max's Money Adventure

Learning objective: To understand the value of money and how we use it to buy things in our community.

Max the monkey is at the local market to buy some fruit for his friends. Look at the coins below and help Max choose what to draw in his shopping basket.

Draw: Draw a large, sturdy woven basket in the middle of the page. Beside the basket, draw Max the monkey looking excited. Around the basket, draw a variety of British coins (like 1p, 2p, and £1 coins) and some pieces of fruit like apples or bananas. Keep the style friendly, colourful, and clear, with plenty of white space for the child to add their own drawings.



Label words: Penny · Pound · Coins · Shopping · Basket · Fruit

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a shiny 1p coin inside Max's empty basket.
2. Step 2: Draw two delicious apples that Max wants to buy with his money.
3. Step 3: Label your drawing using words from the word bank.
4. Step 4: If an apple costs 10p, how many 1p coins do you need to pay for one apple? Draw them here.
5. Step 5: Draw a happy face next to Max to show how he feels when he shares his fruit with his friends.
