

Keeping Safe Online with Kit the Fox

Learning objective: To help children understand that they should always talk to a trusted adult if they see something online that makes them feel worried or unsure.

Colour in the picture of Kit the Fox using your favourite colours. Once you have finished, ask your teacher or a grown-up to help you write the names of the people you can talk to if you are worried.

Colour this: A large, friendly line-art illustration of Kit the Fox sitting comfortably on a soft rug. Kit is holding a tablet with a blank screen, smiling gently.
