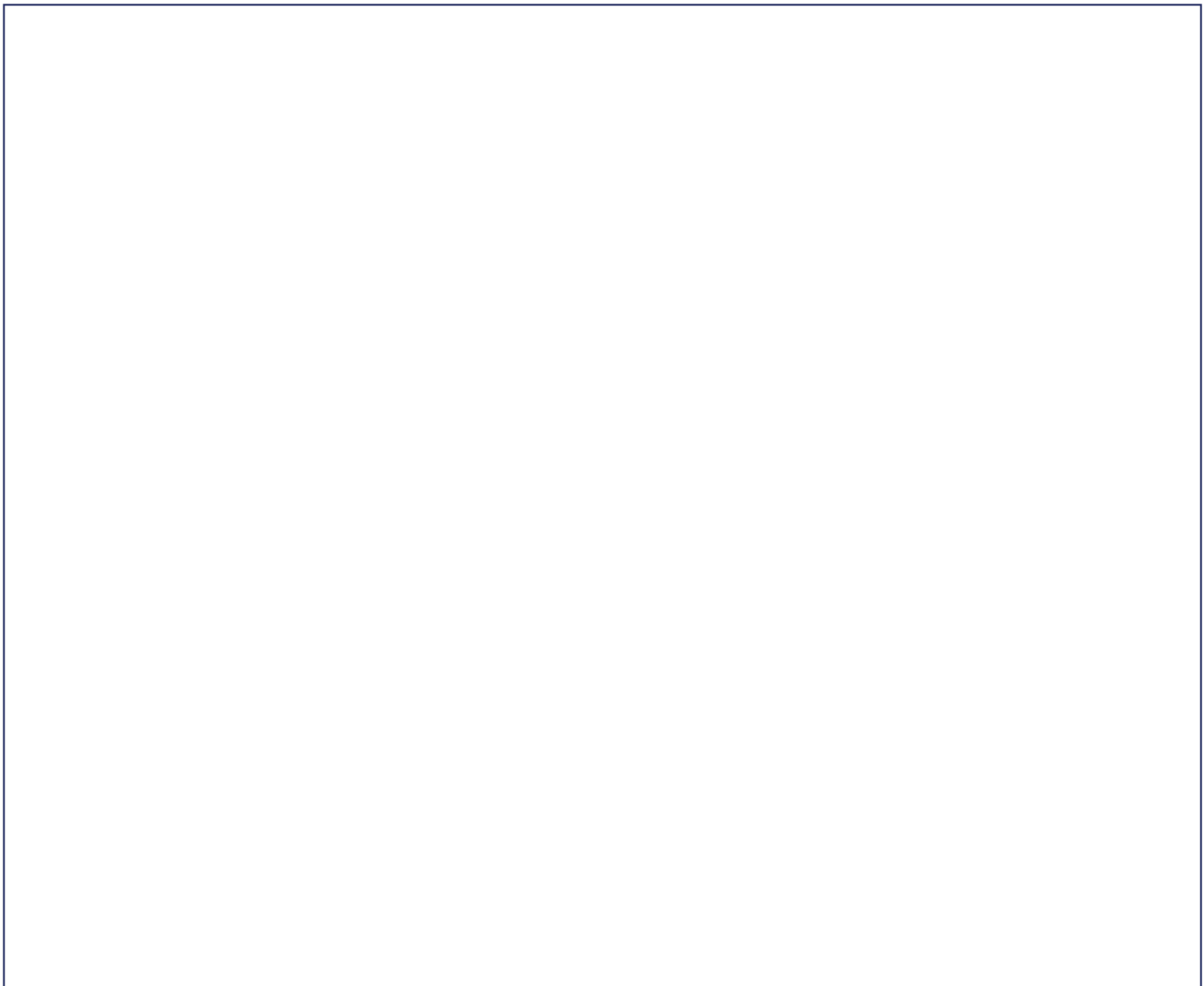


Staying Safe Online with Kit the Fox

Learning objective: To identify ways to stay safe online and understand who to talk to if something makes you feel worried.

Kit the Fox is learning how to be safe on the internet. Use the drawing space below to show how you can be a digital hero. Follow the steps carefully and add labels to your picture.

Draw: Draw a large scene showing Kit the Fox using a tablet. Include a shield symbol to represent safety. Use bright colours to make the scene look friendly and welcoming. Include a person next to Kit to represent a trusted adult.



Label words: Password · Trusted Adult · Private · Kind · Screen

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a computer or tablet screen. In the middle, draw Kit the Fox playing a game. Label the screen 'Private'.
2. Step 2: Draw a shield next to the screen. Write the word 'Password' on the shield to show how we protect our accounts.
3. Step 3: Draw a speech bubble coming from Kit that says, 'I am being kind online!'
4. Step 4: Draw a person standing near Kit. Label this person 'Trusted Adult'. Why should you talk to them if you see something upsetting?
