

Staying Safe Online with Kit the Fox

Learning objective: To identify ways to stay safe online and understand the importance of keeping personal information private.

Read the front of each flashcard to see the question. Flip the card to check if your answer matches the one provided. Use the word bank to help you.

What is a 'private' detail?	What should you do if someone online makes you feel sad or worried?
Information like your home address, school name, or phone number.	Tell a trusted adult immediately.
What is a 'password'?	Who is a 'stranger' online?
A secret code that keeps your accounts safe from others.	Anyone you do not know in real life.
How should you treat people when you are chatting online?	What does it mean to 'report' something?
Always show kindness and respect, just like in real life.	Telling an adult or using a button to flag content that is unkind or unsafe.
Should you share your password with your best friend?	What is the rule about meeting someone you met online?
No, keep your password secret from everyone except your parents or carers.	Never meet them in real life. It is not safe.
If you see something online that looks scary or wrong, what should you do?	Why do we keep our location private?
Close the screen and find a trusted adult to help.	To keep ourselves safe and stop people from finding out where we live.
