

Staying Safe with Leo the Lion

Learning objective: To identify ways to stay safe and know who to ask for help when feeling unsafe.

Leo the Lion wants to help you stay safe. Look at the situations below. Decide if the action is a 'Safe Choice' or an 'Unsafe Choice'. Write the correct answer in the box. Use the word bank to help you.

Word bank: Safe Choice · Unsafe Choice · Trusted Adult · Help · Permission

1. 1. You are playing in the park and a stranger asks you to help them find their lost dog. Is this a Safe Choice or an Unsafe Choice? (2 marks)

2. 2. You feel worried or scared about something. You go to find your teacher or a parent to talk about it. Is this a Safe Choice or an Unsafe Choice? (2 marks)

3. 3. Someone you do not know offers you a sweet or a toy. You say 'no' and walk away quickly to find a grown-up. Is this a Safe Choice or an Unsafe Choice? (2 marks)

4. 4. Who is a 'Trusted Adult' you could talk to if you feel unsafe? (Write one name or role, e.g., Mum, Dad, or Teacher). (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of yourself standing with your 'Trusted Adult'.



Extension challenge: Write one sentence about why it is important to tell a trusted adult if you feel worried. Start your sentence with: 'I would tell a trusted adult because...'
