Learning objective: To identify key facts and traditions related to Bonfire Night (Guy Fawkes Night) in the UK.

When is Bonfire Night celebrated?

On the 5th of November each year.

Who was Guy Fawkes?

A man who tried to blow up the Houses of Parliament in 1605.

What is a bonfire?

A large outdoor fire used to celebrate on the 5th of November.

What do we call the colourful lights in the sky?

Fireworks.

Why do we celebrate this night?

To remember the failed Gunpowder Plot.

What are sparklers?

Small handheld fireworks that glow and sparkle.

What is the main safety rule for fireworks?

Always keep a safe distance and follow adult instructions.

Where is the Houses of Parliament located?

In London.

What is a traditional treat eaten on Bonfire Night?

Toffee apples or parkin cake.

What does Max the Monkey say about safety?

Always stand back and stay safe near the fire!
