What is a 'Creation Story'?

A story that explains how the world and everything in it began.

Who is a Creator?

A being or power that is said to have made the universe.

What does 'Origins' mean?

The point or place where something starts or begins.

What is 'Faith'?

A strong trust or belief in something, often religious.

What is a 'Sacred' text?

A book or writing that is holy to a specific religion.

What is the 'Universe'?

All of space, the stars, the planets, and everything that exists.

Why do people tell creation stories?

To help explain why we are here and what our purpose is.

What is 'Nature'?

The physical world, including plants, animals, and the landscape.

What is a 'Belief'?

Something a person accepts as true, even if they cannot see it.

What is a 'Beginning'?

The first part of something; the start.
