What do we call the time when we stand still to think about the soldiers?	What is another name for Remembrance Day?

Why do we wear a poppy?	What was the main goal of the soldiers who fought in the wars?

What colour is the Remembrance poppy?	Who do we remember on Remembrance Day?
Red	The brave soldiers who died in wars.
How do we show respect during the two-minute silence?	What does 'remembrance' mean?
