

My Sacred Text Treasure

Learning objective: To identify that sacred texts are special books for religious communities and to show respect for these items.

Follow the steps below to draw and label a special book. Use your best handwriting for the labels.

Draw: Draw a large, thick book resting on a soft, colourful cushion. The book should look very old and important. Add beautiful, swirling patterns on the cover. Around the book, draw a quiet, peaceful room with a candle or a lamp. Use bright colours like gold, blue, and purple to make the book look special. Add labels to point to the cover, the pages, and the cushion.



Label words: Sacred text · Cover · Page · Golden writing · Special box

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, rectangular book in the middle of your page. Draw a special cloth cover over it. What does 'sacred' mean to you? (Use the sentence starter: A sacred text is...)
