Learning objective: To identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, and to identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

Read the front of each flashcard to Nova the owl. Then, flip the card over (or check the answer provided) to see if you are correct! Use these to help you remember how we group different animals.

Which animal group lives in water, has scales, and uses gills to breathe?

Which animal group has dry, scaly skin and is cold-blooded?

Which animal group spends part of their life in water and part on land?
