

Autumn Adventures with Nova

Learning objective: To identify and describe the changes that happen in the natural world during the season of autumn.

Colour in the picture of Nova the owl enjoying the autumn season. Once you have finished colouring, use the labels to identify the parts of the tree and the weather signs.

Colour this: A large, friendly-looking barn owl named Nova wearing a tiny knitted scarf, perched on the branch of a large oak tree. The tree has some leaves still attached and some swirling through the air. On the ground, there is a pile of crunchy, fallen leaves of different shapes (oak and maple) and a small acorn. In the top corner, draw a round, bright sun that is starting to set, showing that the days are getting shorter. Use clear, thick black outlines suitable for a Year 1 student to colour.



Steps:

1. Label the part of the tree where the leaves are changing colour.
2. Label the object on the ground that has fallen from the tree.
