6. 6. True or False: Humans can change a habitat by building houses. (1 mark)

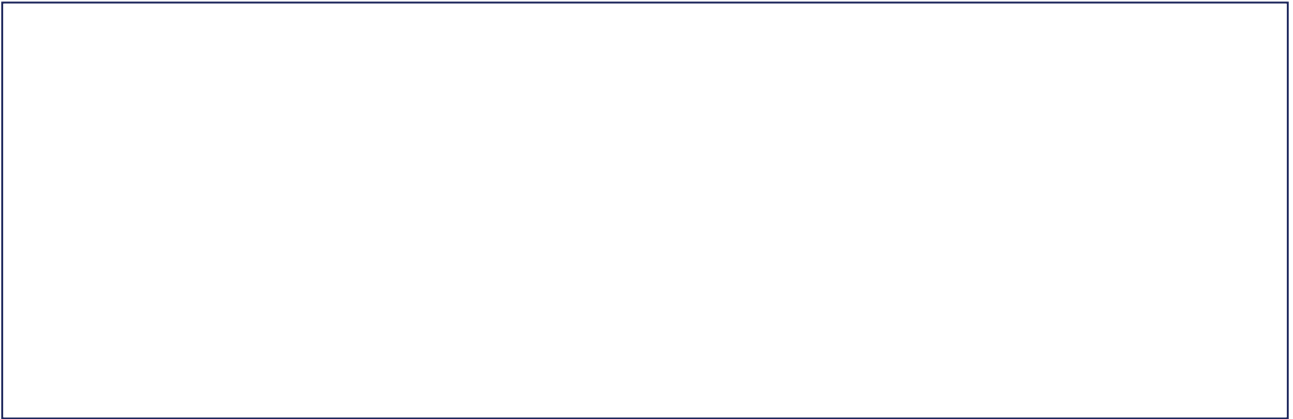
7. 7. What does an animal use to stay safe from the weather? A) a car, B) a bag, C) shelter*, D) a book. (1 mark)
