- Deciduous trees, like the oak, drop their leaves when the weather gets cold.
- Evergreen trees, like the holly, stay green even in the middle of winter.

Did you know? Did you know? Some trees are called 'evergreen' because they keep their green leaves all year round, while 'deciduous' trees lose their leaves every single autumn!
