Word bank: roots · stem · leaves · flower

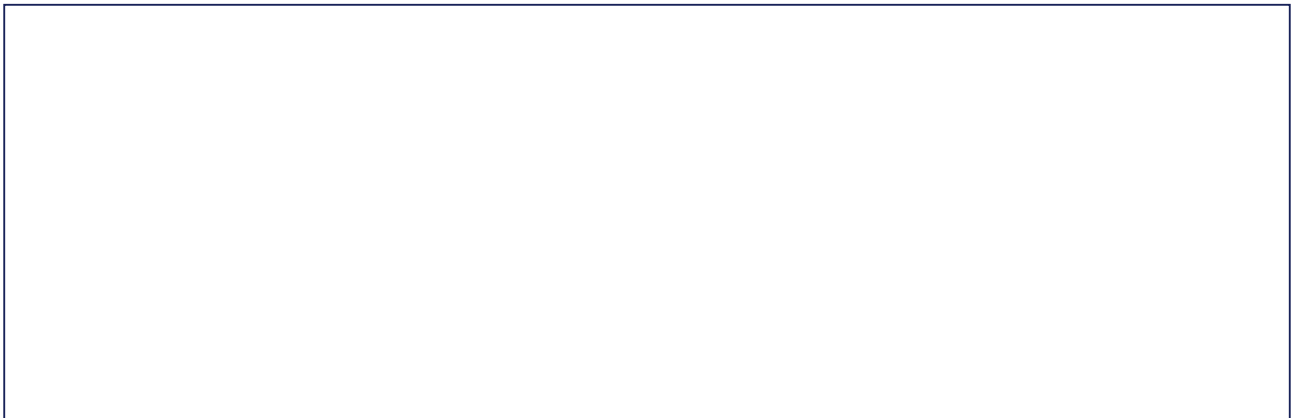
1. 1. The _____ grow under the soil. They soak up water for the plant. (2 marks)
