

Nova's Space Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and draw the main components of our Solar System, including the Sun and the planets.

Follow the steps below to complete your space diagram. Use your pencil to draw clearly. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a scene of the Solar System. On the left, draw a large, glowing Sun. In the middle, draw the Earth as a blue and green circle. Draw a small, grey circle near the Earth for the Moon. Draw a dashed circular line around the Sun to show the Earth's orbit. Keep the background dark to show space.



Label words: Sun · Planet · Orbit · Earth · Moon

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, bright circle on the left side of your paper. This is the Sun. Label it.
2. Step 2: Draw a smaller circle representing the Earth. Draw a curved line to show its path around the Sun. This path is called an orbit.
3. Step 3: Draw a tiny circle next to the Earth. This is the Moon. Label it.
4. Step 4: Draw one more planet in the space. Label it 'Planet'.
