Earth	The Moon
What force keeps us on the ground and planets in space?	Is the Sun a planet or a star?
Gravity	A star
What is the name for the group of planets and the Sun?	Does the Earth orbit the Moon, or does the Moon orbit the Earth?
The solar system	The Moon orbits the Earth
What do we call a large object that orbits a star?	How long does it take for Earth to orbit the Sun once?
A planet	One year (about 365 days)

Stars	A sphere (like a ball)
