Learning objective: To identify and describe the life cycle of plants and animals during the spring season.

1. 1. Is a tiny green Bud a plant or an animal? (2 marks)

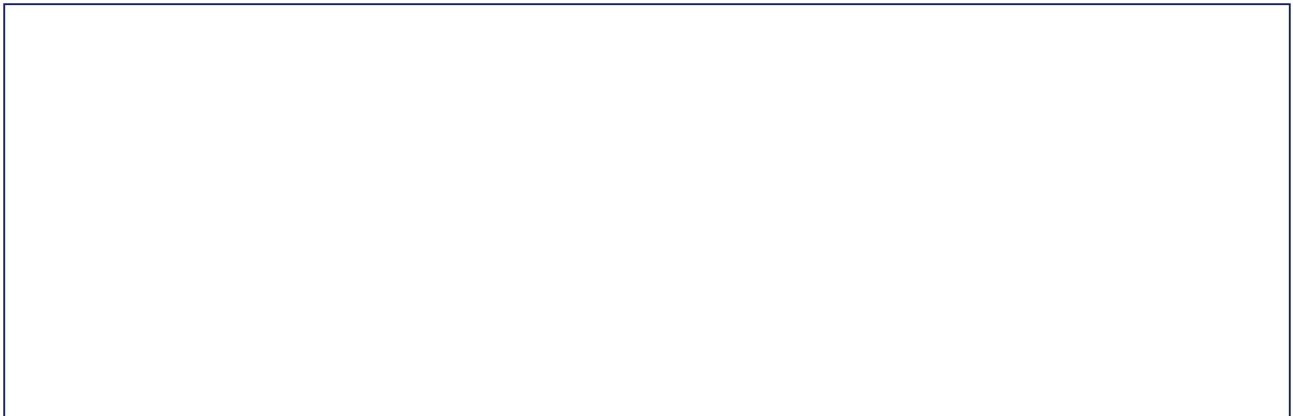
2. 2. Is a fluffy young Lamb a plant or an animal? (2 marks)

3. 3. Is a Seedling growing in the soil a plant or an animal? (2 marks)

4. 4. Is the slippery Frogspawn found in the pond a plant or an animal? (2 marks)

5. 5. Is the colourful Blossom on the tree a plant or an animal? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a spring garden. Include one plant, such as a flower, and one animal, such as a bird or a bee.



Extension challenge: Nova asks: 'Why do you think we see more animals and plants in the garden during spring instead of winter?' Write one sentence to explain your idea.
