

Nova's Water Cycle Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and label the main stages of the water cycle.

Follow the steps below to draw and label the water cycle. Use the word bank to help you spell the labels correctly.

Draw: Draw a large landscape scene. Include a bright sun in the sky, a large grey cloud, and a blue lake at the bottom. Use arrows to show the water moving in a circle from the lake to the sky and back down again. Keep your drawing clear so you can add your labels next to each part.



Label words: Evaporation · Condensation · Precipitation · Collection · Sun

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a big yellow sun in the top corner. Draw wavy lines rising from a puddle to show water turning into vapour. Label this 'Evaporation'.
2. Step 2: Draw a fluffy cloud above the wavy lines. Label this 'Condensation'.
3. Step 3: Draw raindrops falling from the cloud. Label this 'Precipitation'.
4. Step 4: Draw a blue river or lake at the bottom of your page. Label this 'Collection'.
