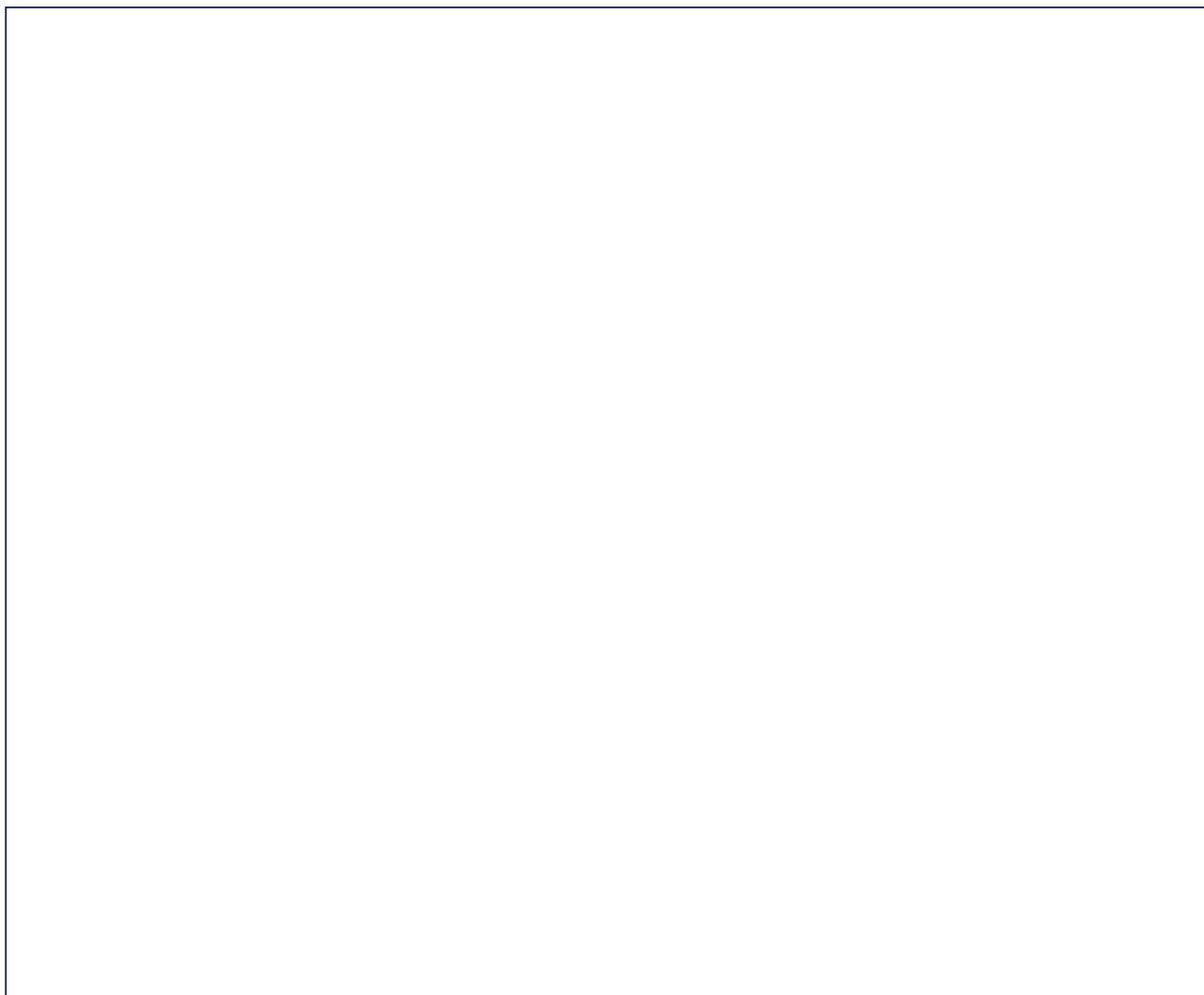


Zara's Abstract Art Adventure

Learning objective: To explore abstract art by using shapes, lines, and colours to express feelings and patterns, following the style of Zara the Zebra.

Today, we are going to be abstract artists! Abstract art doesn't have to look like a real object, like a house or a tree. Instead, we use shapes and colours to show how we feel or what we see in our imaginations. Look at the box below and create your own masterpiece using Zara's favourite patterns.

Draw: In the large empty space provided, create an abstract artwork. Use a variety of lines (straight, curvy, and zigzag) and shapes (circles, squares, and triangles). Do not worry about drawing 'real' things. Focus on making the page look interesting and colourful, just like Zara's art. You can overlap your shapes and use different patterns inside them.



Label words: Zigzag · Circle · Bright · Swirl · Pattern · Colourful

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a big, wobbly circle in the middle of your page to be your main shape.
2. Step 2: Add three zigzag lines coming out from your circle.
3. Step 3: Fill the empty spaces with your favourite bright colours.
4. Step 4: Label your drawing using one word from the word bank.
5. Step 5: Tell a friend why you chose the colours you used for your art.
