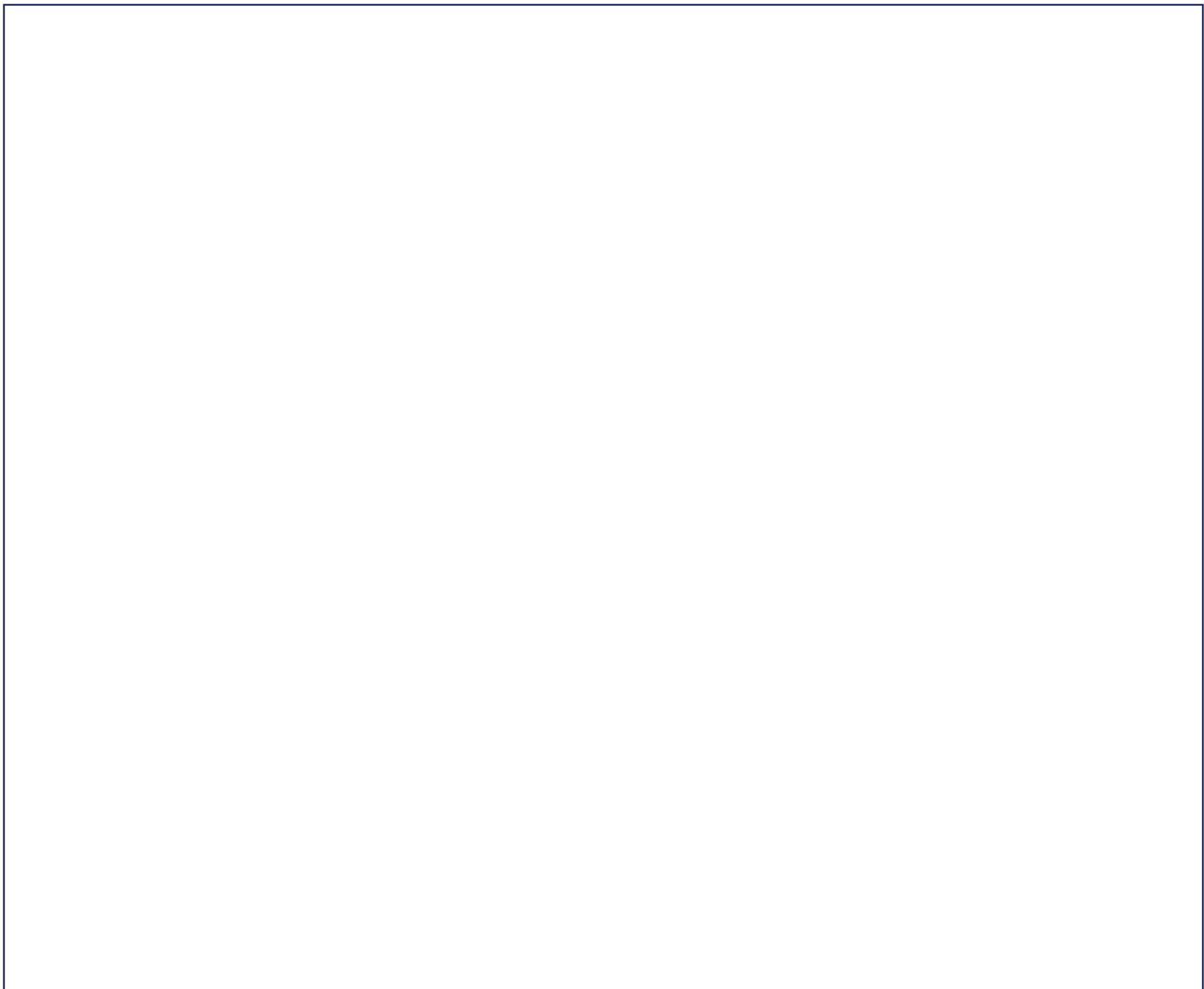


Zara's Texture Treasure Hunt

Learning objective: To explore the art of collage by selecting and arranging different textures to create a picture.

Join Zara the Zebra on an art adventure! A collage is a picture made by sticking different things together. Look at the shapes below and think about what you could use from around the classroom or garden to make them feel special. You might use bits of paper, fabric, leaves, or shiny foil.

Draw: Draw a large sun in the centre of the page and three stars in the corners. Use your pencil to draw patterns like zig-zags or spots inside the shapes. Once your patterns are drawn, stick different textures onto your shapes to turn your drawing into a collage.



Label words: rough · smooth · shiny · bumpy · soft · collage

Steps:

1. Step 1: Choose a piece of paper that feels 'rough'. Glue it inside the big circle to start your collage sun.
2. Step 2: Find something 'shiny' and glue it to the corners of your page to look like twinkling stars.
3. Step 3: Draw a line from the word 'bumpy' to a part of your picture that you have made with a textured material.
4. Step 4: If you bought a special piece of glitter for your collage that cost 2p, and you had a 5p coin, how much change would you get back?

5. Step 5: Write your name at the bottom of your artwork like a real artist!
