

Zara's Magical Colour Mixing Lab

Grab your brushes and let's make the world bright with Zara the Zebra!

- Red and yellow are primary colours; when we mix them together, they turn into orange.
- Blue and yellow are primary colours; when we mix them together, they turn into green.
- Red and blue are primary colours; when we mix them together, they turn into purple.
- Primary colours are the special 'starting' colours that cannot be made by mixing others.
- Secondary colours are the new colours we get when we swirl two primary colours together.
- You can always change the shade of a colour by adding a little bit of white paint.

Did you know? Did you know? If you mix all three primary colours together in the right way, you can create a deep, earthy brown, just like the colour of the soil in a garden!
