

Zara's Colourful Circles

Learning objective: To explore the art of Wassily Kandinsky by creating a picture using circles and bright colours.

Follow Zara the Zebra's art adventure! Look at the patterns around you and use your favourite colours to draw your own Kandinsky-inspired circle art.

Draw: Draw a large square box on your paper. Inside the box, draw lots of circles of different sizes. Some circles should be inside other circles (like a target). Use bright crayons or pencils to colour them in. Make sure your circles touch each other to create a busy, happy pattern, just like Zara the Zebra's favourite paintings.



Label words: circle · colour · bright · pattern · square · shape

Steps:

1. What shape can you see the most in your drawing?
2. Can you count how many circles you drew? Write the number here.
3. Which colour did you use for your biggest circle?
4. Do your circles look like they are dancing or sleeping?
5. If you sold a painting like this for £2, would you need two £1 coins?
